DESCRIPTION OF A 1.000 ACRE TRACT

Situated in L.L. 72 and L.L. 112 of Sections 18 and 24, T.9, R.14, Athens Township, Athens County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found at the North-west corner of John Slaters Town Lots Addition the The Plains

Thence, with the lines of a 1.01 acre tract: N 31°47'52" E, 17.33' to an iron pin found N 53°41'29" W, 200.19' to an iron pin found;

Thence, with the lines of a 2.00 acre tract (237-649) N 36°08'15" E,128.69' to an iron pin found; N 48°41'54" W,314.32' to an iron pin found; S 31°17'40" W, 113.20 feet to an iron pin set and being the point of beginning for the tract of land herein described:

Thence, continuing along the West-line of the 2.00 acre tract: S 31°17'40" W, 261.79 feet to a point in First Street, passing an iron pin found at 236.79 feet;

Thence, along First Street: N 55°01'54" W,170.35 feet;

Thence, leaving First Street N 31°17'40" E,250.88 feet to an iron pin set, passing an iron pin found at 25.00 feet;

Thence, S 58°42'20" E, 170.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 1.000 acres.

Subject to all easements and rights of way of record.
