Description of survey for Jack L. Ward Tract 1

Being a part of a tract of land transferred to Jack L. and Beth Ann Ward as recorded in Official Records Volume 123 at page 765 Athens County Recorder's Office, Athens County, Ohio, also being a part of Farm Lot 86, Sections 19 and 20, Township-9, Range-14, Athens Township, Athens County, State of Ohio and more particularly described as follows;

Beginning for reference at the southeast corner of said Farm Lot 86, T-9, R-14;

Thence North 00°00'00" West a distance of 784.08 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set;

Thence South 59°48'01" West a distance of 501.07 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set;

Thence North 00°00'00" West a distance of 491.53 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set being the principal point of beginning for the tract herein described;

Thence South 72°47'30" West passing thru a 5/8" iron pin at a distance of 445.05 feet and going a total distance of 466.14 feet to a point in the centerline of Township Road 31;

Thence along said centerline the following six courses;
