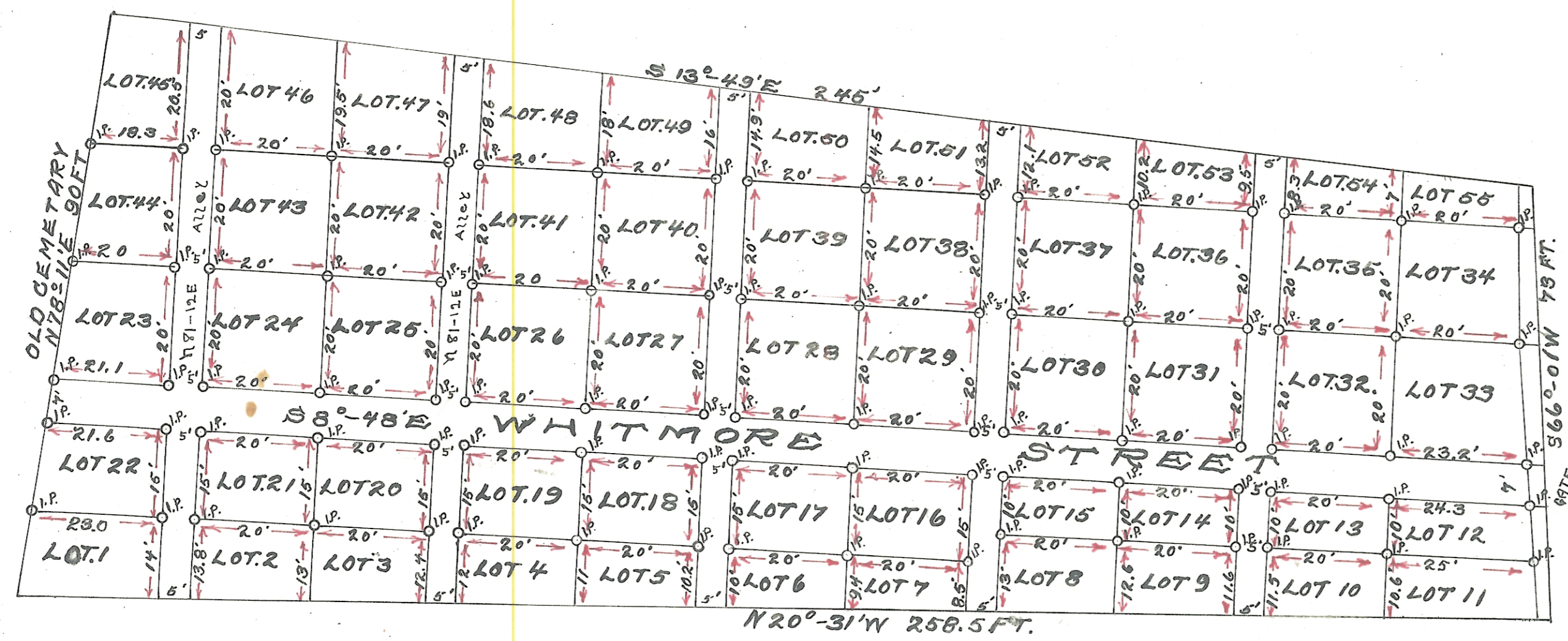
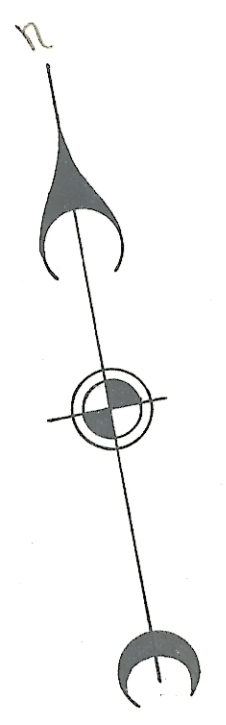


PLAT OF THE NEW EDITION OF BUCHTEL-CEMETERY

Hyde, by deed dated the 24 day of April 1918 and which said deed is recorded in deed Book No. 125 page 385 of the records of deeds of Athens County, Ohio.
For said sub-division for cemetery purposes commence at the South East corner of the Cemetery established by N. O. Whitmore, thence North 78-11 East 93 ft., thence South 13-49 East 245 ft., thence South 66-01 West 73 ft., thence North 20-31 West 258.5 ft. to place of beginning and containing .38 acres more or less.
