## DESCRIPTION OF PARCEL NO. 1

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Athens, Township of Bern, being part in Fraction 36, Section 15 and part in Fractions 30 and 36, Section 21, Range 12 West, Township 7 North, of "The Ohio Company First Purchase", and being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a $5 / 8$ " iron pin found capped "R.L.S. 7224 " in the west line of Section 15 and in the cast line of Section 21 at the southeast comer of Fraction 18 (Note: Reference bearing on the north line of Fractions 30 and 36 and the south line of Fraction 18 used as South $88^{\circ} 52^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime}$ East as described in Official Records Volume 236, Page 419 of the Athens County Recorder's Office.);

Thence, from said Point of Beginning and running with the line of a 266.96 acres tract as conveyed to Mark J. Howdyshell by Official Records Volume 203, Page 629 of the Athens County Recorder's Office, South $51^{\circ} 12$ ' $41^{\prime \prime}$ East a distance of 95.61 feet to a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ iron pin found capped "R.L.S. 7224 " in the centerline of a gas line right-of-way;

Thence, with the centerline of said gas line right-of-way and the north line of a 266.96 acres tract as . conveyed to Mark J. Howdyshell by Official Records Volume 203, Page 629 of the Athens County Recorder's Office, South $42^{\circ} 16^{\prime} 42^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 741.00 feet to a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ iron pin found capped "R.L.S. 7224", passing through another a $5 / 8$ " iron pin found capped "R.L.S. 7224 " on the west line of Section 15 at distance of plus 110.73 feet;

Thence, leaving the gas line right-of-way and leaving the Howdyshell property line, North $84^{\circ} 39^{\prime} 05^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of $4,256.80$ feet to a point in the centerline of Township Road No. 201, passing through four iron pins set at distances of plus $3,916.80$ feet, plus $4,016.80$ feet, plus $4,116.80$ feet, and plus 4,216.80 feet, respectively;

Thence, with the centerline of Township Road No. 201 and the east line of a 20.99 acres tract as conveyed to Michael P. and Gina R. Whale by Official Records Volume 239, Page 99 of the Athens County Recorder's Office, the following four courses:

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(1) North $45^{\circ} 00^{\circ} 09^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 64.08 feet to a point;
(2) Thence North $53^{\circ} 33$ ' $06^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 172.58 feet to a point;
(3) Thence North $61^{\circ} 16^{\prime} 53^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 197.43 feet to a point;
(4) Thence North $67^{\circ} 11$ ' $15^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 183.67 feet to a point in the north line of Fraction 30 ;

Thence, leaving the road with the north line of Fractions 30 and 36, South $88^{\circ} 52^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime}$ East a distance of $5,189.83$ feet to The Point of Beginning, passing through a marked stone found at a distance of plus 119.84 feet;

Containing 50.113 acres, more or less, of which:
49.992 acres are out of Fractions 30 and 36 in Section 21 and
0.121 acres are out of Fraction 36 in Section 15.

Subject to all legal right-of-ways, easement, restrictions, reservations, and zoning regulations of record.
Subject to the right-of-way of Township Road No. 201.
Subject to the 100 -Year Flood Plain restrictions, if applicable.


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Subject to a 50.00 feet wide easement being reserved unto the grantors, their heirs, and or assigns, forever. Said easement being for the purpose of running utilities to other parcels of land on or near Township Road No. 201. Said easement runs in a southeast to northwest direction across the west end of the abovedescribed property with the west line of said easement being the centerline of Township Road No. 201. Containing 0.709 acres, more or less, of easement.

The above-described premises being conveyed are subject to the rights, restrictions, reservations, exceptions, limitations, agreements, convenants, and conditions listed in Attacliment "A", which shall be made a part of, either by attachment or reference, all deed, conveyances, instruments, leases, transfers or assignments of said premises. Said restrictions are the same as previously described in Official Records Volume 236, Page 419 of the Athens County Recorder's Office.

Subject to all of the existing leases of record from which the previous grantor (Ref: O.R. Vol. 236, Page 421) excepts and reserves all royalty income until December 31, 2011. The reservation of income from oil and gas described above shall terminate at 12.00 midnight December 31, 2011, at which time the rights to income from oil and gas leases in affect at that time shall automatically revert to the then present owner of the described premises, or any part thereof, without further action by the owner of this reservation or owner of the premises, or any part thereof.

All iron pins set are $1 / 2$ " $\times 30$ " rebar capped and labeled "Claus 6456 ".
The bearings in this description are for angle calculations only and are based on the north line of Fractions 30 and 36 and the south line of Fraction 18 used as South $88^{\circ} 52^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime}$ East as described in Official Records Volume 236, Page 419 of the Athens County Recorder's Office.
