ORDINANCE NUMBER 1297

To authorize annexation of certain territory to the City of Athens, Ohio.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Athens, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the annexation of the following described territory: Situate in the City of Athens, Township of Athens, State of Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point found by starting at the northwest corner of Farm Lot No. 27, Town 9, Range 14, and running thence south along the west line of said Farm Lot No. 27 a distance of 1799.74 feet to the place of beginning; thence continuing along said west line of said Farm Lot South a distance of 547 feet to the center of the Athens-Guyssville Road known as East State Street and U.S. 50 as now situated, and thence easterly with an internal angle of 85° 20 minutes along the center line of said road a distance of 600 feet; thence north parallel to said west line of Farm Lot No. 27 and with an internal angle of 94° 40 minutes a distance of 413.72 feet; thence west with an internal angle of 90 degrees a distance of 199.336 feet to the east line of land heretofore sold to the State of Ohio; thence northerly and parallel with the west line of said Farm Lot No. 27 a distance of 117 feet; thence west and parallel to the center line of said East State Street 400 feet to the place of beginning.

Said Parcel is subject to an easement for highway purposes 30 feet in width along the south boundary. Said parcel contains a total calculated area of 6.83 acres, more or less.

to the City of Athens, Ohio, be and the same is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That the City Solicitor, William Rowland, be, and he is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

The following is an exact and true copy of a Resolution passed by the Athens County Commissioners at their Regular Meeting March 5, 1956 and recorded in their Journal 22, Page 372.

Mr. Polin offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption: WHEREAS on the 20th day of February 1956 the Council of the City of Athens, Ohio passed an ordinance authorizing the annexation of the following described Real Estate, which land is contiguous to the City of Athens, Ohio and is situated in the Township of Athens, County of Athens, State of Ohio, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point found by starting at the northwest corner of Farm Lot No. 27, Town 9, Range 14, and running thence south along the west line of said Farm Lot No. 27 a distance of 1799.74 feet to the place of beginning; thence continuing along said west line of said Farm Lot South a distance of 547 feet to the center of the Athens-Guyssville Road known as East State Street and U.S. 50 as now situated, and thence easterly with an internal angle of 85 degrees 20 minutes along the center line of said road a distance of 600 feet; thence north parallel to said west line of Farm Lot No. 27 and with an internal angle of 94 degrees 40 minutes a distance of 413.72 feet; thence west with an internal angle of 90 degrees a distance of 199.336 feet to the east line of land heretofore sold to the State of Ohio; thence northerly and parallel with the west line of said Farm Lot No. 27 a distance of 117 feet; thence west and parallel to the center line of said East State Street 400 feet to the place of beginning.

Said parcel is subject to an easement for highway purposes 30 feet in width along the south boundary. Said parcel contains a total calculated area of 6.83 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, the Solicitor of the City of Athens, Ohio presented to the County Commissioners of Athens County, Ohio, at their Meeting February 27, 1956, a petition containing an accurate description of the territory which petition requested the annexation of said territory to the said City of Athens, Ohio, and an accurate plat of said territory accompanying said petition, and

WHEREAS, the said County Commissioners have found that there are no electors residing within the territory sought to be annexed at the present time, and

WHEREAS, the only owners of land within the said territory are the State of Ohio, Division of Natural Resources, and Athens Medical Building, Inc., an Ohio Corporation, and

WHEREAS, said State of Ohio, Division of Natural Resources, and Athens Medical Building, Inc., an Ohio corporation, have requested said annexation and have expressed in writing the fact that they have no objection to said annexation, therefore, no public notice or waiting period is necessary.

WHEREAS, the Athens County Commissioners, Athens, Ohio, that said Board of County Commissioners does hereby agree to and accept the petition of said City of Athens, Ohio, for the annexation of the above described territory.
