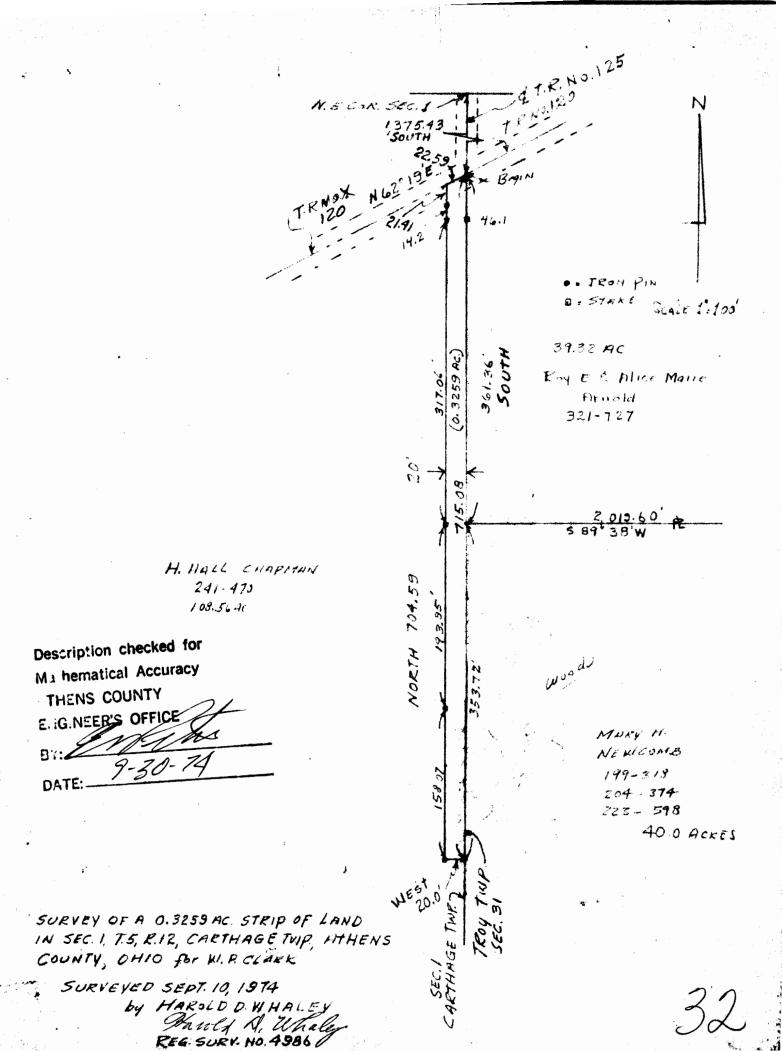

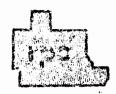

Dear Mr. Ackerman:

Mrs John Newcomb owns a 40 acre landlocked tract in Section 31, Troy Township and wants to sell. To do so an access must be provided to Twp. Rd. 120.

This acreage was transferred to Mrs Newcomb in 1948 by her father and it is not known why it became landlocked. Over the years Mr Newcomb cropped the land and gained access across land owned by Minnie Jones et al. by a friendly agreement. It is not possible to obtain a legal access from Jones.

The adjoining land to the west of the 40 acres fronts on TR#120 and is owned by H. Hall Chapman who has agreed to sell a strip of ground off the East side of his 40 acre parcel, to be used only as an access to the Newcomb 40 acres. His terms are that it can be no wider than 20 feet; that nothing can be built on it and that the owner must build any fences required. A width wider than 20 feet will not be considered.

Frank Goebel of Coolville has agreed to buy both the above mentioned parcels and is aware of these conditions as well as your 40 foot roadway requirements. Therefore, it is requested that a variance be granted,
