Dear Ryan,

The sketch that you faxed to me cannot be approved as proposed. The access easement makes it a subdivision and the development would have to be presented as a subdivision. We do have lessened standards for road access to three lots or less for subdivisions. The Health Dept. would get involved with lot configuration and easements for sewage with a subdivision. There would be a minimal review process and a plat would have to be recorded.

As proposed, the easement would have to be removed or the development will be considered a subdivision under the Ohio Revised Code and local regulations.
