Being a part of the west half of the southeast quarter of Section 17, Township 5, Range 12, Carthage Township, Athens County, Ohio, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at an iron pin in the center line of Athens County Road #53 and the southeast corner of the west half of the southeast quarter of section 17, thence along the center line of county road #53 and the middle line of the southeast quarter N 3° 22' 24" E 821.99 feet to a point in the center line of Township road 154 and being the principal place of beginning of the tract herein to be described; thence with the center line of township road 154 S 60° 45' 27" W 178.70 feet to a point; thence continuing along the center line S 63° 50' 40" W 355.04 feet to a railroad spike at the southeast corner of the Richard and Blondeline Robinson tract; thence leaving said road and with the east side of the Robinson tract N 23° 11' 00" W 255.20 feet to an iron pin and passing over a reference iron pin at 13.8 feet; thence N 44° 56' 45" E 493.44 feet to an iron pin; thence \$ 33° 40' 00" E 408.56 feet to the place of beginning and passing over a reference iron pin at 395.52 feet. The tract as surveyed contains 3.867 acres, more or less, subject to all legal easements of record.
