Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin set which is assumed to bear South 01°54'01" East a distance of 17.82 feet and South 88°05'59" West a distance of 332.88 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section 17, Township-5, Range-12;

Thence South 01°54'01" East a distance of 403.60 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set; Thence South 88°05'59" West a distance of 539.64 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set; Thence North 01°54'01" West a distance of 403.60 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set;

Thence North 88°05'59" East a distance of 539.64 feet to the principal point of beginning containing 5.00 acres± subject to all legal easements and rights-ofway.

#### DESCRIPTION OF CENTERLINE SURVEY OF A 50 FOOT EASEMENT

Being a part of a tract of land transferred to David E. and Tamra S. Russell as recorded in Official Records Book 124 at Page 157, Athens County Recorder's Office, Athens County Ohio, also being a part of Section 17, Township-5-North, Range-12-West, Carthage Township, Athens County, State of Ohio and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West line of a 5.00 acre± tract which is assumed to bear South 88°05'59" West a distance of 872.52 feet and South 01° 54'01" East a distance of 235.42 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section 17, Township-5, Range-12;

Thence along the centerline of a 50 foot easement the following two courses:

- 1. South 88°23'38" West a distance of 835.72 feet to a point;
- 2. South 89°36'05" West a distance of 206.09 feet to a point in the centerline of County Road #53 said point being the terminus of said 50 foot easement.



**SECOND TRACT:** Being in Section 11, Town 5, Range 12, of the Ohio Company's Purchase; beginning at the northwest corner of said Section; thence south 80 rods to land deeded to Timothy Russell, Jr.; thence east 80 rods to the center of said quarter; thence north to the section line; thence west along said section line to the place of beginning, containing Forty (40) acres, more or less; and being the same premises conveyed to Eber M. Russell by John Russell and wife by deed, dated April 25, 1892, and recorded in Volume 78, Page 203, Record of Deeds of Athens County, Ohio.

THIRD TRACT: Commencing 9.22 chains from the northeast corner of Section 17, Town 5, Range 12, at the east end of the road bought by E. M. Russell from Andy Chambers Frame; thence south 30 rods; thence northwest 32 3/4 rods to the above mentioned road; thence east along said road 16 rods to the place of beginning, containing one and onehalf (1 1/2) acres, more or less; and being the same premises conveyed to Eber Russell by E. G. Antle and wife by deed, dated September 13, 1907 and recorded in Volume 104, Page 375, Record of Deeds of Athens County, Ohio;

FOURTH TRACT: Beginning at a point at the south side of a private road which bears from the northeast corner of Section 17, Town 5, Range 12, West 12.90 chains, and south 27 links which is the beginning of this description; thence south 20 degrees east 11.94 chains; thence south 5.32 chains; thence north 32 degrees west 15.20 chains; thence west 10.77 chains; thence north 70 degrees west 1.67 chains; thence north 47 degrees west 1.50 chains; thence north 12 degrees west 2.43 chains to the south line of said private road mentioned above; thence east 17.75 chains to the place of beginning, containing Eleven (11) acres, more or less; and being the same premises conveyed to Eber Russell by Lolie B. FIRST EXCEPTION: Commencing about 19 rods east of the northwest section corner of Section 11, Town 5, Range 12, at a chestnut oak tree about 18 inches in diameter, running a southeasterly course over a cave between two springs; thence to a little white oak 12 inches in diameter about 49 rods from the beginning; thence northeast to a walnut tree about 16 inches in diameter; thence to a white oak about 20 inches in diameter; thence up to another white oak about 21 inches in diameter; thence in a northwesterly course to a sand rock about 6 inches in diameter to the Section line; thence 50 rods or about 50 rods due west to the place of beginning, containing six (6) acres more or less; said FIRST EXCEPTION being the same premises conveyed by Eber M. Russell and wife to Lewis A. Dye by deed, dated July 21, 1897, and recorded in Volume 78, Page 289, Record of Deeds of Athens County, Ohio.
