## DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY OF VANDERHOOF CEMETARY

Situated in Sections 1 and 2 of T.5, R.12, Carthage Township, Athens County, Ohio and being all of the existing Vanderhoof Cemetary as presently fenced and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in County Road 65, said point bears South 87 degrees 27 minutes 34 seconds East, 623.62 feet from a fence corner taken to be the South-west corner of Section 2;

Thence, along County Road 65, N 18°52'12" W,174.29 feet to a point;

Thence, leaving said road and along an existing fence-lines and the lines of Edsel and Bernice M. Hart(359-115) ,**S 87°57'55"** E,333.75 feet to an iron pin set at a fence corner, passing an iron pin set at 41.47 feet;

Thence, along an existing fence line and the line of Edsel and Bernice Hart, S 0°22'54" E,191.43 feet to an iron pin set at a fence corner;

Thence, along an existing fence and the line of James R. Williams (91-618) N 87°35'03" W,269.46 feet to a point in County Road 65, passing an iron pin set at 245.27 feet;

Thence, along said road, N 18°52'10" W,28.52 feet to the point of beginning and containing 1.317 acres.

Subject to all easements and rights of way of record.

Iron pins set are 5/8" by 30" long rebar

Bearings are assumed and are to be used to denote interior angles only.
