Commencing for reference at a stone, the northwest corner of Fracton 4; thence North 89°26'27" East 1200.00 feet to a iron pipe; thence South 00°04'53" West 813.49 feet to a found railroad spike in the center of Athens County Road 28, the northwest corner of a 5.00 acre tract described in Volume 377 Page 763 of the Athens County Deed Records; thence along the west property line of said 5.0 acre tract South 00°02'22" West 760.07 feet to a found 5/8 inch rebar, the southwest corner of aforesaid 5.0 acre tract and THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the west property line of tract 1 described in Volume 340 Page 913 of the Athens County Deed Records South 00°02'22" West 640.39 feet to a point on the south line of said Fraction 4; thence along the south line of said Fraction 4 North 89°34' 36" East (passing through a 30 inch Oak tree with wire in it at 311.80 feet) for a total distance of 1185.80 feet to a found 1 inch pinch pipe at the southwest corner of a 2.46 acre tract described in Volume 304 Page 380 of the Athens County Deed records; thence along the west property line of said 2.46 acre tract North 05°31'03" West 376.48 feet to a found 1 inch pinch pipe at the northwest corner of said 2.46 acre tract; thence along the north property line of said 2.46 acre tract North 82°14'15" East 264.15 feet to a found 5/8 inch rebar in the center of Athens County Road 28, the northeast corner of said 2.46 acre tract; thence along the center of Athens County Road 28 North 02°19'51" West 35.46 feetto a found 5/8 inch rebar at the northwest corner of a 4.33 acre tract described in Volume 349 Page 79 of the Athens County Deed Records; thence continuing along Athens County Road 28 North 04°30' 16" West 318.83 feet to a found 1/2 inch rebar at the southeast corner of a 5.25 acre tract described in Volume 307 Page 25 of the Athens County Deed Records; thence leaving the said Athens County Road 28 and along the south property line of said 5.25 acre tract North 73°12'55" West (passing a found 3/4 inch pipe at 20.10 feet) for a total distance of 582.98 feet to a found 3/4 inch pipe at the southwest corner of said 5.25 acre tract; thence along the west property line of said 5.25 acre tract North 02°26'06"
