DESCRIPTION OF A 5.20 ACRE TRACT

Situated in Section 3, T. 10, R. 14, Dover Township, County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the North-west corner of the South-west quarter of Section 3;

thence, South 18 degrees 54 minutes 24 seconds East, a distance of 2265.28 feet to an iron pin found;

thence, North 52 degrees 25 minutes 21 seconds East, a

distance of 1002.95 feet to an iron pin found, said point being the POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence, North 52 degrees 25 minutes 19 seconds East, a distance

of 233.13 feet to an iron pin found; thence, North 37 degrees 25 minutes 24 seconds East, a distance of 255.78 feet to a point in Township road 326, passing an iron pin found at 233.41 feet;

thence, following said road, South 41 degrees 38 minutes 00 seconds East, a distance of 135.00 feet to a point; thence, South 75 degrees 33 minutes 00 seconds East, a distance

of 209.40 feet to a point;

thence, leaving said road, South 59 degrees 37 minutes 18 seconds East, a distance of 111.74 feet to an iron pin set in Township road 326 right of way;

thence, leaving said right of way, South 63 degrees 01 minute 55

seconds West, a distance of 210.14 feet to a point;

thence, South 49 degrees 24 minutes 28 seconds East, a distance iron pin set of 154.00 feet to an iron pin set, passing an 11.33 feet;

thence, South 53 degrees 07 minutes 15 seconds West, a distance

of 392.38 feet to an iron pin set; thence, North 49 degrees 25 minutes 24 seconds West, a distance of 454.04 feet, passing an iron pin set at 226.31 feet, to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 5.20 acres.

Subject to all easements and rights of way of record. All iron pin set are 5/8 inch x 30 inch long rebar.
