thence  $N 84^{\circ} 00' E$ , 55.44 feet to a point,  
thence  $S 10^{\circ} 45' E$ , 205.00 feet to a point in the center of the Hocking river,  
thence  $N 83^{\circ} 38' W$ , 883.64 feet with the center line of the Hocking river to a point,  
thence  $N 6^{\circ} 05' W$ , 100.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 3.14 acres.

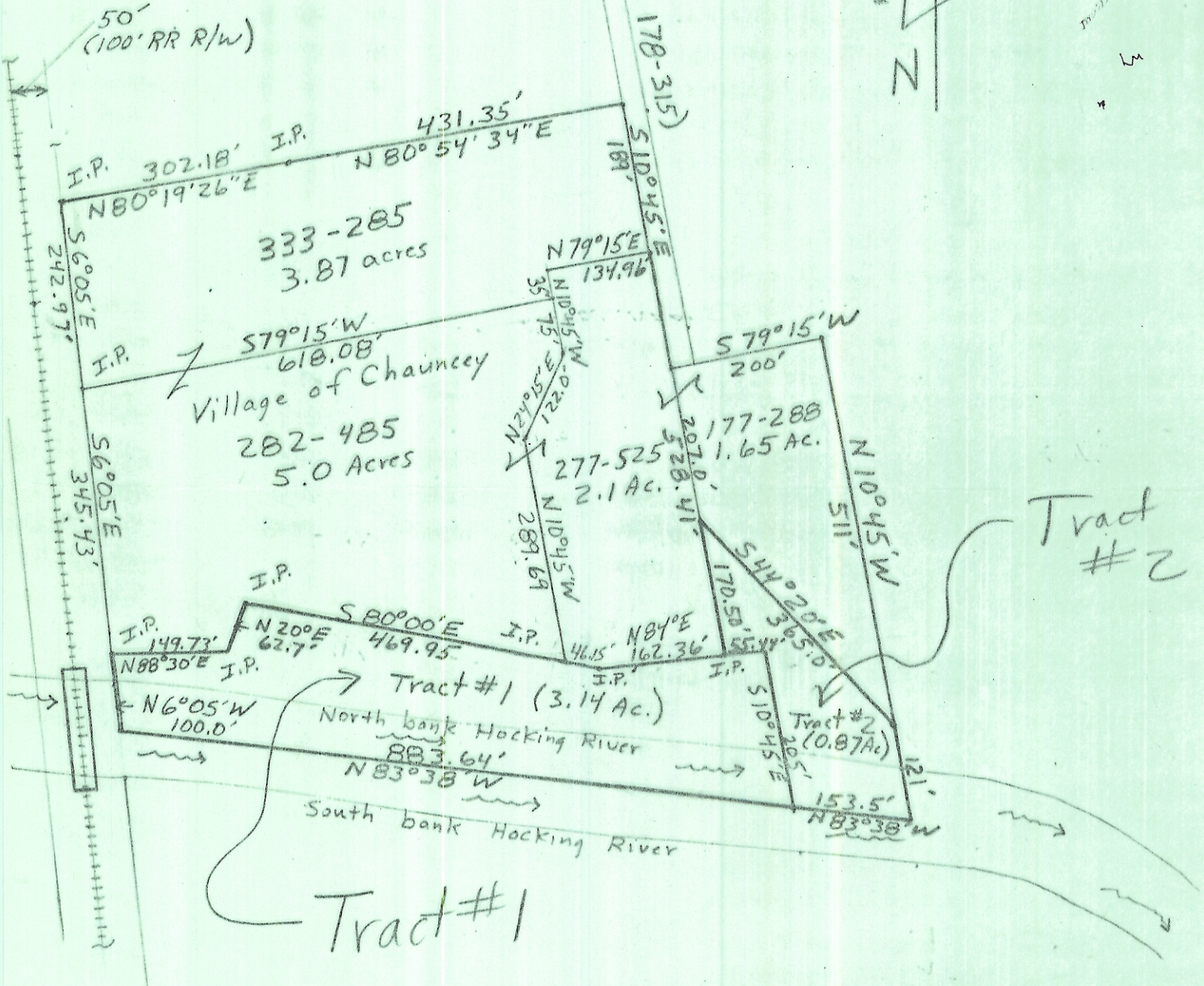
