R. thence north seventy three (73) degrees and ten (10) minutes east 411 feet. thence south fifty-three (53) degrees east 1564.3 feet. thence south eighteen (18) degrees and thirty (30) minutes east 337.9 feet. thence south forty-six (46) degrees and forty (40) minutes east 342.7 feet. thence south sixty eight (68) degrees and forty five (45) minutes east 296.9 feet. thence south eighty six (86) degrees and thirty (30) minutes east 725.6 feet to about center of Oak Street in J. V. Stocklein's Addition to the village of Glouster, thence north thirty nine (39) degrees and thirty (30) minutes east 84.5 feet to the southwest corner of lot number 1003 in said addition, thence south sixty-nine (69) degrees and fifteen (15) minutes east along the south side of lots numbered 1003-988 & 968 and across streets and alleys 455 feet to the southwest corner of lot no. 953 in said addition. thence north twenty (20) degrees and fifteen (15) minutes east along the rear of lots numbered 952-954-955-956-957-958-959-960 to the northwest corner of lot numbered 960 thence north forty (40) degrees and thirty (30) minutes east 542.8 feet to the north line of fraction numbered 12 thence south eighty six (86) degrees east along the north line of fraction 12, 269 feet to the center of the public road leading to Burr Oak, thence down the center of said road south thirty three (33) degrees and forty-five (45) minutes east 49.1 feet to the place of beginning.

An accurate plat map of which territory together with the petition for its annexation and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the county commissioners in relation thereto are on file with the clerk of the council of said village, he and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
