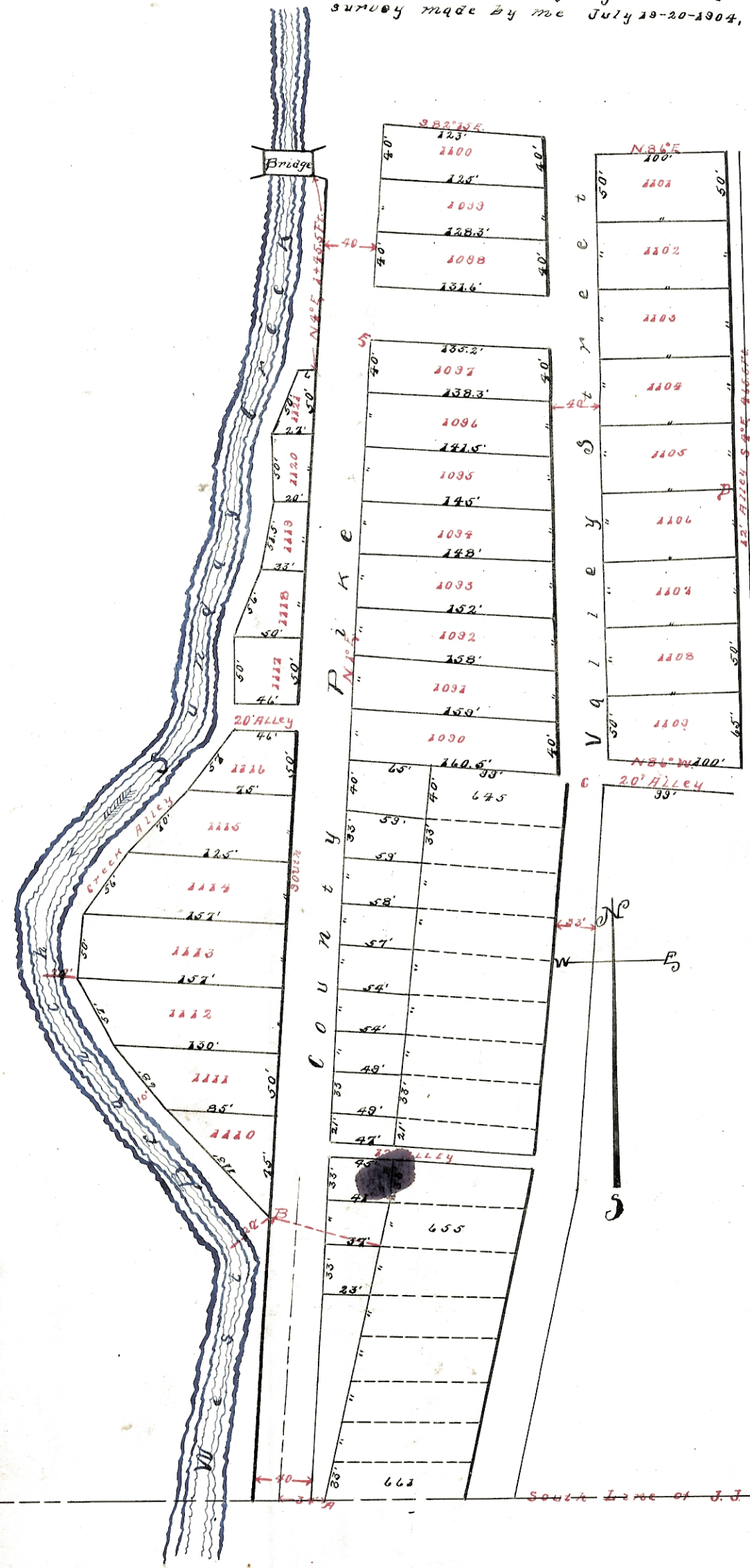

Allen his wife who hereby releases her right and expectancy of dower therein, do hereby acknowledge the making of the same to be their voluntary act and deed and that they do hereby dedicate the streets and alleys shown thereon to and for public use forever, reserving and excepting therefrom all coal therein and under said lots, streets and alleys together with the usual mining rights.

S. 80° E. from the center of the county pike and at the S.W. corner of lot no. 661 heretofore located April 12<sup>th</sup> 1889 thence with said lot no. 661 N. 12° E. 231 ft. to N. W. corner of lots no. 655, thence N. 3 1/2° E. 337 ft. to the N.W. corner of lot no. 645 thence S. 82 1/4° E. 115 1/2 ft. to the corner of Street C, thence S. 86° E. 120 ft. thence W. 4° 28' 48 1/2 ft. thence S. 86° 21' 14 1/2 ft. thence N. 4 1/2° 10 ft. to N.E. corner of lot no. 1100 thence N. 82 ft. N. 12 1/2 ft. to the east boundary of the county pike, thence S. E. 160 ft. to E. N.W. corner lot no. 1099, thence S. 65 N. 50 ft. to N. E. corner of lot no. 1121, thence N. 26 ft. to center of the west branch of Sunday Creek, thence southward with the center of said creek to S.
