thence, leaving said Lot 232 following said Street, North 27 degrees 29 minutes 01 second East, a distance of 19.85 feet to a Rail Road Spike set, said Rail Road Spike set being the POINT OF BEGINNING of the following described tract;

thence, leaving said Street on a random line, North 69 degrees 37 minutes 32 seconds West, a distance of 308.01 feet to an iron pin set in the West line of the Grantor's tract;

thence, following said West line, North 7 degrees 32 minutes 48 seconds East, a distance of 202.70 feet to an iron pin set at the Grantor's Northwest corner;

thence, following the Grantor's North line, South 75 degrees 02 minutes 31 seconds East, a distance of 127.08 feet to an iron pin set;
