

DESCRIPTION OF A 20.00 ACRE TRACT

Situated in Section 26, T.4, R.13, Lodi Township, Athens County, Ohio and being a part of a tract of land as described in Volume 424, Page 2626 of the Official Records of Athens County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stone found at the South-east corner of the North one-half of the South-west Quarter of Section 26;

Thence, along new lines created by this survey:

S 45 degrees 13 minutes 30 seconds W,1540.57 feet to an iron pin set;

N 26 degrees 18 minutes 02 seconds W,505.26 feet to a point in Township Road 68, passing an iron pin set at 373.51 feet;

Thence, along said road:

N 21degrees 38 minutes 21 seconds W, 150.34 feet;

N 07 degrees 47 minutes 00 seconds W, 85.06 feet;

N 07 degrees 03 minutes 52 seconds E. 291.83 feet;

N 01 degrees 48 minutes 05 seconds W, 149.71 feet;

N 23 degrees 21 minutes 19 seconds W, 60.63 feet;

Thence, leaving said road and along the South-line of David and Tobi Wood (467-2659 O.R.)

S 86 degrees 23 minutes 34 seconds E, 1380.04 feet, passing an existing iron pin at 25.74 feet, to the point of beginning and containing 20.00 acres.

Subject to all easements and rights of way of record.

Iron pins set are 5/8" by 30" long rebar with plastic I.D. cap. Stamped "Branner P.S. 6805" Bearings based on Grid North N.A.D. 83
