

The Town of New England is situated in the North West corner of Section No 34, Town No 6 Range No 1, Ohio Company's Purchase, in Rome Tp. N. State of Ohio. The North line of said Sect. No 34, bears S 88° E. to which all of the streets, lots and alleys run either parallel or at right angles, the width of the streets and the dimensions of the lots are indicated in figures on the plat. Stones are set at the N.W. corners of In Lots No 1, 17, 33 and at the N.W. corners of each out lots, which have stones at the N. E. corners.
