

Pleasant Valley, is situated in the South part of James C. Burson's 109 acre lot in Fraction No 32, Town 4 Range 13, O. C. P. Main street bears N 19 1/2° W, and 40 links wide, all of the streets and lots are either parallel or at right angles with main street, unles, their particular bearing is noted on the plat. Pierce street bears S 89° E and is 60 links wide, all of the other streets are 90 links wide. The alleys are 16 1/2 links wide and at right angles with main street

N.B. The distance is in all cases taken in chains & links. Stones are set at the follow corners, the N.W. of No 1, N.W. of No 4 the N.W. of No 8, the N.E. of No 9, the S.E. of 16, the S.E. of the N.E. 25, the N.E. of 29, the N.W. 30, the S.W. of 37
