Commencing at a found iron pin at the Northeast corner of said Fraction 7; thence along the east line of a 40 acre tract described in Volume 291 Page 556 of the Athens County Deed Records South 3 degrees 32 minutes 29 seconds West, a distance of 1941.56 feet to a point in Rome Township Road 145, THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along said line South 03 degrees 32 minutes 29 seconds West, a distance of 272.33 feet to a point in Rome Township Road 145; thence leaving the said Rome Township Road 145 and along the south line of the grantor's aforementioned 40 acre tract Worth 85 degrees 53 minutes 20 seconds West (passing a found cross notohed stone at 22.14 feet) for a total distance of 790.05 feet to a set iron pin at the southwest corner of the grantor; thence leaving the south line of the grantor and along the west property line of the grantor North 3 degrees 32 minutes 29 seconds East, a distance of 272.33 feet to a set iron pin; thence leaving the west line of the grantor South 85 degrees 53 minutes 20 seconds East (passing a set iron pin at 759.65 feet) for a total distance of 790.05 feet to the point of beginning and containing 4.9390 acres, and being a part of a 40 acre tract described in Volume 291 Page 556 of the Athens County Dead Records.

Commencing at a found iron pin at the Northeast corner of said Fraction 7, said found iron pin is THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the east line of the grantor South 3 degrees 32 minutes 29 seconds West, a distance of 1941.56 feet to a point; thence leaving the east line of the grantor North 85 degrees 53 minutes 20 seconds West (passing a set iron pin at 30.37 feet) for a total distance of 790.05 feet to a set iron pin on the west line of the grantor; thence along the west line of the grantor North 3 degrees 32 minutes 29 seconds East, a distance of 1924.86 feet to a set iron pin on the north line of aforesaid Fraction 7; thence along the north line of said Fraction 7 South 87 degrees 06 minutes 00 seconds East, a distance of 790.06 feet to the point of beginning and containing 35.0610 acres, and being a part of a 40.0 acre tract described in Volume 291 Page 556 of the Athens County Deed Records.
