thence, following said Road, South 65 degrees 03 minutes 48 seconds East, a distance of 308.75 feet to a found Rail Road Spike at the Southwest corner of a 5.09 acre tract (Basis of Bearing) described in Volume 132 Page 856 Official Records of Athens County;

thence, following said tract, South 65 degrees 03 minutes 10 seconds East, a distance of 329.79 feet to a point:

thence, South 55 degrees 21 minutes 50 seconds East, a distance of 89.28 feet to a found Rail Road Spike:

thence, leaving said tract, South 50 degrees 09 minutes 15 seconds East, a distance of 197.38 feet to a point;

thence, leaving said Road, South 28 degrees 34 minutes 17 seconds West, a distance of 570.06 feet to an iron pin set, passing an iron pin set at 13.47 feet;

thence, South 73 degrees 43 minutes 05 seconds East, a distance of 536.78 feet to an iron pin set on the West right-of-way of State Route 50;

thence, following said right-of-way, South 27 degrees 08 minutes 44 seconds West, a distance of 115.49 feet to a right-of-way monument found;

thence, South 35 degrees 46 minutes 45 seconds West, a distance of 177.09 feet to a right-of-way monument found;

thence, South 37 degrees 41 minutes 02 seconds West, a distance of 54.40 feet to an iron pin set; thence, leaving said right-of-way, North 69 degrees 27 minutes 40 seconds West, a distance of 1062.69 feet to an iron pin set in the grantor's West fence line;

thence, following said fence line, North 7 degrees 19 minutes 58 seconds East, a distance of 496.37 feet to a fence corner post;

thence, North 7 degrees 03 minutes 41 seconds East, a distance of 221.40 feet to a point; thence, North 8 degrees 37 minutes 33 seconds East, a distance of 234.18 feet to a fence post; thence, North 9 degrees 53 minutes 29 seconds East, a distance of 71.78 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; said described tract containing 20.000 acres (871,198.4822 square feet).


