Thence, from said Point of Beginning and running with the centerline of State Route No. 329, North 35°00'00" East a distance of 332.73 feet to a point, passing over the centerline west end of a 50.00 feet wide right-of-way reserve at a distance of plus 131.62 feet;

Thence, leaving the road, South 68°56'09" East a distance of 219.00 feet to a an iron pin set, passing through two iron pins set at distances of plus 34.90 feet and plus 68.00 feet, respectively;

Thence South 02°33'57" East a distance of 218.69 feet to an iron pin set, passing over the centerline of the east end of the aforementioned 50.00 feet wide right-of-way reserve at a distance of plus 94.22 feet;

Thence North 86°31'16" West a distance of 405.75 feet to The Point of Beginning, passing through an iron pin set at a distance of plus 335.14 feet;

Containing 1.825 acres, more or less.

Subject to the right-of-way of State Route No. 329.

- (1) South 37°27'50" East a distance of 69.22 feet to a point;
- (2) Thence South 77°14'38" East a distance of 89.90 feet to a point;
- (3) Thence North 71°02'23" East a distance of 205.28 feet to The True Point of Ending in the east line of the above described 1.825 acres tract;

Containing 0.418 acre, more or less, of easement.

All iron pins set are 5/8" x 30" rebar capped and labeled "Claus 6456".
