Being all of a tract of land transferred to Evelyn Kay Everett from Brad Lee Everett as described in Official Record 244, Page 484 and recorded in the Athens County Recorder's Office.

Located in Fraction No. 6, Section 15, Township 11, Range 14, of the Ohio Company's Purchase, Trimble Township, Athens County, and in the Village of Glouster, Ohio.

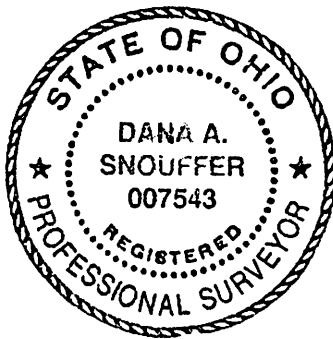
Commencing at an iron pin found marking the Northwest corner of Fraction No. 6 in Section No. 15; thence along the North line of Section No. 15, South 86 deg. 00 min. East - 656.96 ft. to a 5/8 inch rebar pin set (ref. passing over an iron pipe found at 501.66 ft.); thence from this true place of beginning and continuing along the North line of Section 15, South 86 deg. 00 min. East 1228.00 ft. to a 5/8 inch rebar pin set; thence leaving the section line South 43 deg. 20 min. West - 635.00 ft. to a railroad spike set in the North line of Look Out Street "Extended"; thence along the North line of the street, North 36 deg. 37 min. 23 sec. West - 394.00 ft. to a 5/8 inch rebar pin set; thence North 69 deg. 30 min. 09 sec. West - 465.00 ft. to a 5/8 inch rebar pin set; thence North 60 deg. 00 min. West - 137.00 ft. to the place of beginning and containing 5.656 acres, more or less .

Bearing system for this survey based on the North line of Section 15 as being South 86 deg. 00 min. East an assumed meridian used to denote angles only.



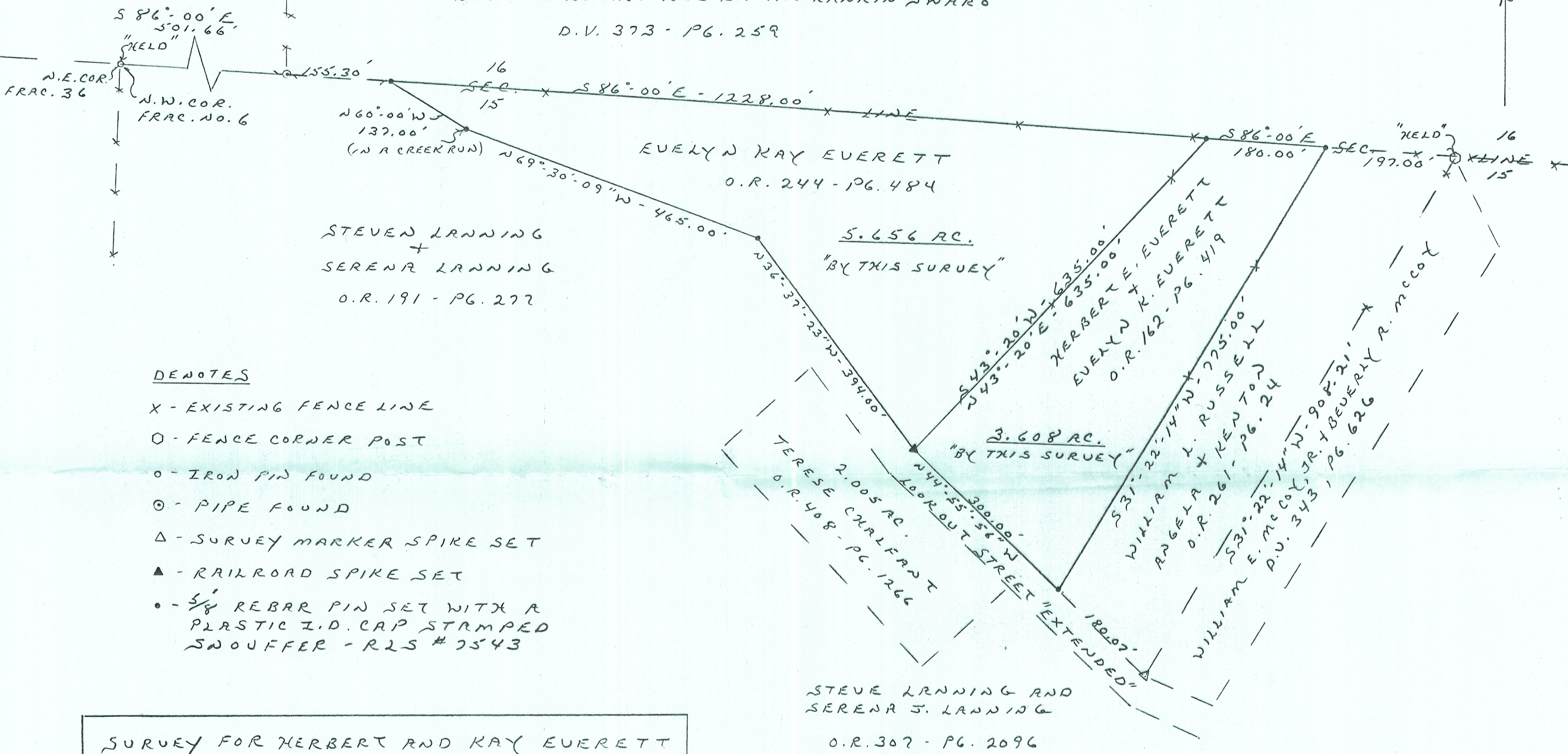

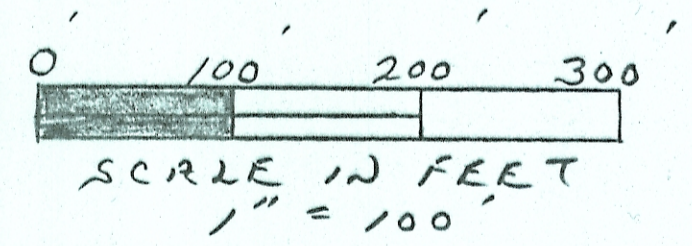
