

DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR K & H PARTNERS, LLC (TRACT 1)

Situated in the State of Ohio, Athens County, Township of Troy, Fraction 5, Section 10, Township 5 North, Range 11 West, and being a portion of that same tract or parcel of land described in a deed to Warren H. Calaway, found in the Recorders Office of Athens County, Ohio, in Official Record Book 343 on Page 522, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at Steel Fence Post, found, at the southeast corner of Fraction 5, of Section 10, thence with the south line of said Fraction, N 80-16-50 W 676.15 feet to a Roof Bolt, found, corner to Block, and being the **True Place of Beginning** for the tract or parcel herein to be described, thence continuing with the south line of said Fraction for one (1) line;

N 80-16-50 W 675.74 feet to a 5/8-inch by 30-inch reinforcing rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "WILLOW LAND SURVEYING", hereinafter referred to as a "Rebar", set, corner to K & H Partners, LLC, thence with K & H Partners for one (1) line;

N 09-58-20 E 997.07 feet to a Rebar, set, on the south Right-Of-Way for U.S. Route 50, thence with the Right-Of-Way for three (3) lines;

Being a curve to the left whose Radius is 5,869.58 feet, whose delta angle is 03-27-48, whose Chord Bearing and Distance is **\$ 89-34-10 E 354.73 feet** to a Rebar, set, thence;

\$ 86-19-30 E 310.19 feet to a Rebar, set, thence;

Being a curve to the left whose Radius is 5,904.58 feet, whose delta angle is 00-10-18, whose Chord Bearing and Distance is **N 85-36-50 E 17.69 feet** to a 6-inch round Concrete Monument, found, corner to Calaway, thence with Calaway, Pullins, said Calaway, Vanscoy, and said Block for one (1) line;

\$ 09-56-50 W at 195.08 feet passing a Rebar, set, at 549.56 feet passing a 1-inch Iron Pipe, found, at 739.73 feet passing a 5/8-inch Rebar, found, **In All 1,091.30 feet** to the True Place of Beginning containing **16.24 acres**, more or less, as surveyed by Willow Land Surveying, PLLC in September, 2014, as shown on a "**PLAT OF PARTITION SURVEY FOR K & H PARTNERS, LLC**" dated the 24th day of September, 2014, attached hereto and made part of this description.

DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR K & H PARTNERS, LLC (TRACT 2)

Situated in the State of Ohio, Athens County, Township of Troy, Fraction 5, Section 10, Township 5 North, Range 11 West, and being that portion lying outside the Right-Of-Way for U.S. Route 50, of the same tract or parcel of land described in a deed to Warren H. Calaway, found in the Recorders Office of Athens County, Ohio, in Official Record Book 410 on Page 1144, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at Steel Fence Post, found, at the southeast corner of Fraction 5, of Section 10, thence with the east line of said Fraction and Section, N 10-02-30 E 1109.00 feet to a 5/8-inch by 30-inch reinforcing rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "WILLOW LAND SURVEYING", hereinafter referred to as a "Rebar", set, on the west Right-Of-Way for State Route 124, corner to Coulson, and also being the **True Place of Beginning** for the tract or parcel herein to be described, thence with Coulson for two (2) lines;

N 80-27-20 W 163.95 feet to a Rebar, set, thence;

\$ 09-42-10 W 176.00 feet to a Rebar, set, corner to Pullins, thence with Pullins for one (1) line;

N 84-18-40 W at 504.83 feet passing through a 30-inch Shagbark Hickory, In All 516.18 feet to a Rebar, set, in line of Calaway, thence with Calaway for one (1) line;

N 09-56-50 E 195.08 feet to a 6-inch round Concrete Monument, found, on the south Right-Of-Way for U.S. Route 50, thence with the south Right- Of-Way for U.S. Route 50 for two (2) lines;

Being a curve to the left whose Radius is 5,904.04 feet, whose delta angle is 06-33-59, whose Chord Bearing and Distance is **N 82-14-40 E 676.32 feet** to a Rebar, set, thence;

N 68-32-20 E 39.82 feet to a Rebar, set, on the east line of said Fraction and Section and on the west Right-Of-Way for State Route 124, thence with said Section and Right-Of-Way for one (1) line;
