Situated in Section 32, Town 5, Range 11, Troy Township, Athens County, Ohio and described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Section 33 and northwest corner of Section 32; thence on an assumed bearing along the north line of said Section 32 East, a distance of 825.00 feet to a found stone\* at the southwest corner of a 22.089 acre tract described in Volume 55 Page 17 of the Athens County Official Deed Records; thence along the north line of said Section 32 and the south line of said 22.089 acre tract South 79 degrees 41 minutes 31 seconds East, a distance of 615.24 feet to the southeast corner of said 22.089 acre tract, THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along the north line of Section 32 South 79 degrees 41 minutes 31 seconds East, a distance of 1059.16 feet to an iron pin found\* at the grantor's northeast property corner; thence leaving the north line of Section 32 and along the grantor's east property line South 13 degrees 10 minutes 52 seconds West, passing a found stone\* at 144.00 feet, for a total distance of 227.51 feet to a point in existing U.S.Route 50; thence along said road the following three bearings and distances: 1) South 84 degrees 15 minutes 51 seconds West, a distance of 240.07 feet to a point; thence 2) North 87 degrees 03 minutes 25 seconds West, a distance of 323.82 feet to a point; thence 3) North 75 degrees 01 minute 42 seconds West, a distance of 480.61 feet to a point at the southeast corner of a 3.110 acre tract described in Volume 55 Page 20 of the Athens County Official Deed Records; thence leaving said road and along the east line of said 3.110 acre tract the following six bearings and distances: 1) North 18 degrees 34 minutes 37 seconds
East, passing a set railroad spike\* at 33.28 feet, for a total
distance of 118.82 feet to a set railroad spike\*; thence 2) North 35 degrees 21 minutes 09 seconds West, a distance of 51.84 feet to a set railroad spike\*; thence 3) North 19 degrees 20 minutes 45 seconds East, a distance of 66.18 feet to an iron pin set\*; thence 4) North 5 degrees 48 minutes 56 seconds West, a distance of 37.81 feet to an iron pin set\*; thence 5) North 14 degrees 44 minutes 42 seconds East, a distance of 39.54 feet to an iron pin set\*; thence 6) North 18 degrees 39 minutes 27 seconds East, a distance of 1.10 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 7.226 acres, and being a part of Tract Two of the tracts of land described in Volume 371 Page 1005 of the Athens County Deed Records.




