Commencing at the northeast corner of said Section 4; thence along the east line of said Section 4, South 01 degrees 29 minutes 38 seconds West 2299.97 feet to an iron pin (adjoining survey); thence along the south property line of a 11.22 acre tract described in Volume 372 Page 825 of the Athens County Deed Records North 83 degrees 32 minutes 37 seconds West 989.86 feet to a railroad spike (adjoining survey); thence along the west property line of a 5.82 acre tract described in Volume 336 Page 821 of the Athens County Deed Records South 04 degrees 07 minutes 23 seconds West 267.82 feet to a spike (adjoining survey) in the center of Athens County Road 61; thence along the centerline of Athens County Road 61 South 78 degrees 09 minutes 31 seconds East 71.91 feet to a spike (adjoining survey); thence South 68 degrees 14 minutes 04 seconds East 33.81 feet to a point, THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence leaving said Athens County Road 61 North 13 degrees 46 minutes 43 seconds East (passing a found iron pin at 40.18 feet) for a total distance of 209.34 feet to a found iron pin; thence South 67 degrees 04 minutes 45 seconds East 131.30 feet to a set iron pin; thence South 24 degrees 42 minutes 04 seconds West (passing a set iron pin at 178.66 feet) for a total distance of 215.88 feet to a point in the center of Athens County Road 61; thence along the center of said Athens County Road 61 North 57 degrees 38 minutes 35 seconds West 59.49 feet to a point: thence North 68 degrees 14 minutes 04 seconds West 32.65 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.5343 acres and being a part of a 5.82 acre tract described in Volume 336 Page 821 of the Athens County Deed Records.

Note: All set iron pins are capped, 5/8 inch diameter and 30 inches in length. The words adjoining survey refer to a survey performed by Harold D. Whaley Registered Land Surveyor Number 4986 dated July 1975. Found iron pins are from a unrecorded survey performed by Chet Waterman Registered Land Surveyor Number 5319, dated May 25, 1983.
