Situated in the northwest quarter of Section 4. Town 5, Range 11 West, Troy Township, Athens County, Ohio and described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of said 6; thence on an assumed bearing North 1,331.57 feet to a point (previous sur vey); thence North 88°50' East 602.70 feet to a found 1 inch pinch pipe(previous THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence on an assumed bearing of North 19°01'50" East (passing a set iron pin at 615.22 feet) for a total distance of 660.68 feet to a point on south line of a 40.60 acre tract described in Volume 58 Page 587 of the Athens County Official Deed Records; thence along said south line South 73°18'31" East 159.65 feet to a point, the northwest corner of a 6.45 acre tract described in Volume 361 Page 643 of the Athens County Deed Records; thence along the west property line of said 6.45 acre tract South 01°36'38" East (passing a found 1 inch rebar at 20.98 feet) for a total distance of 53.43 feet to a found 1 inch pipe; thence South 01°37'17" East 184.64 feet to a found 5/8 inch rebar; thence South 01°30'55" East 337.04 feet to a set iron pin; thence South 05°35'00" West (passing a found 1 inch rebar at 158.17 feet) for a total distance of 186.71 feet to a set railroad spike in the center of Athens County Road 60 (witness a found railroad spike North 72°19'26" West 1.74 feet); thence along the center of said Athens County Road 60 South 87°55'10" West 184.06 feet to a point; thence North 53°29'33" West 150.47 feet to a found 5/8 inch rebar; thence North 51°10'39" West 81.90 feet to a found 5/8 inch rebar; thence leaving the said Athens County Road 60 North 03°24'45" East 47.90 feet to the point of beginning containing 5.0883 acres there being 1.3423 acres out of Parcel One and 3.7460 acres out of Parcel Two of Volume 385 Page 548 of the Athens County Deed Records.

Note: Unless otherwise noted all set iron pins are 5/8 inch diameter rebar 30 inches in length and capped with a plastic identification marker inscribed L.F. Swoyer R.L.S. 6765.


