Situated in the Village of New Marshfield, Township of Waterloo, County of Athens, State of Ohio and being a part of Section 15, Town 11, Range 15, and shown as Lot 178 more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pipe found at the northeast corner of the Richard A. and Linda D. Jones 2.93 acre tract recorded in Volume 351, Page 103 of the Athens County Deed Records, said iron pipe being north 1°05'22" east 568.92 feet from the southeast corner of Section 15; thence north 88°24'48" west 313.50 feet to an iron pin set at the northwest corner of said tract, said iron pin being the place of beginning for the tract of land herein described; thence south 4°50'12" west along the west line of the Jones tract, 395.32 feet to a point in the center of Athens County Road 3, a stone found bearing south 88°49'31" east 47.65 feet; thence north 88°49'31" west 607.42 feet to an iron pin found; thence north 399.20 feet to a stone found; thence south 88°24'48" east 640.87 feet to the place of beginning and containing 5.686 acres.

Subject to all legal rights of way and easements of record.
