PARCEL A

Commencing at a found 3/4 inch diameter iron pin at the northeast corner of a 1.23 acre tract described in Volume 318 Page 193 of the Athens County Deed Records, said found iron pin has a 6 inch square metal plate over the top of it and is located North 71°03'13" East 1,084.53 feet from the northeast corner and is THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; of Fraction 18 of Section 22, Waterloo Township thence North 67°01'15" East 104.92 feet to a set iron pin; thence South 03°29'22" West (passing a set iron for a total distance of 355.36 feet to a point in the pin at 324.66 feet) center of State Route 691; thence along the center of State Route 691 North 86°53'50" West 142.72 feet to a point; thence leaving State Route 691 and along the east property line of aforesaid 1.23 acre tract North 12°26'51" East (passing a found 3/4 inch iron pin at 36.72 feet) for a total distance of 313.38 feet to the piont of beginning containing 0.8897 acres and being part of a 117.66 acre tract described in Volume 331 Page 337 of the Athens County Deed The above described 0.8897 acre tract is to be continuous and contiguous with a 1.23 acre tract described in Volume 318 Page 193 of the Athens County Deed Records. Subject to all easements and right of ways of record.

PARCEL B

Commencing at a found 3/4 inch iron pin underneath a 6 inch square plate, said found iron pin is the northwest corner of a 1.23 acre tract described in Volume 318 Page 193 of the Athens County Deed Records and is North 66°37'26" East -950.76 feet from the northeast corner of Fraction 18 of Section 22 of Waterloo Township, said found iron pin is also THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the west property line of said 1.23 acre tract South 12°26'17" West (passing a found 3/4 inch iron pin underneath a 6 inch square metal plate at feet) for a total distance of 386.74 feet to a point in the center of State Route 691; thence along said State Route 691 South 71°54'53" West 99.84 feet to a point; thence leaving said State Route 691 North 12°26'17" East (passing a set iron pin at 55.22 feet) for a total distance of 415.22 feet to iron pin; thence North 87°56'58" East 88.83 feet to the point of beginning in containing 0.7916 acres and being part of a 117.66 acre tract described
