Situated in the north half of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 8, Town 11, Range 15, Waterloo Township, Athens County, Ohio and described as follows:

Commencing at a found cross marked sandstone at the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of Section 8; thence along the west line of the said northeast quarter of Section 8 on an assumed bearing South 05°15'00" West 207.87 feet to a point in the center of Waterloo Township Road 27, said point is THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along Waterloo Township Road 27 South 58°36'00" East 214.08 feet to a point; thence South 52°16'00" East 74.70 feet to a point; thence South 49°23'00" East 68.50 feet to a point; thence South 34°29'00" East 38.00 feet to a point; thence South 24°12'00" East 8.05 feet to a point; thence leaving said Waterloo Township Road 27 South 70°40'33" West (passing a set iron pin at 26.68 feet) for a total distance of 260.65 feet to a set iron pin; thence North 88°27'27" West 102.46 feet to a set iron pin on the west line of said northeast quarter of Section 8 and the east property line of a 77.23 acre tract described in Volume 382 Page 251 of the Athens County Deed records; thence North 05°15'00" East (passing a set iron pin at 314.27 feet) for a total distance of 325.37 feet to the point of beginning containing 1.5000 acres and being part of a 3.5 acre tract described in Volume 352 Page 655 of the Athens County Deed Records.

Note: All set iron pins are capped 5/8 inch diameter reinforcing bars 30 inches in length.
