Beginning at an iron pin at the North-west corner of Fraction#4, Section 10, thence, along the North-line of Fraction 4 and the south-lines of Hanning (56-245 O.R.) and Hoot Owl Inc. (372-665)

S 83° 33' 46" E,1423.66 feet to a railroad spike in County Road 100 where a stone on the north-line of said Fraction bears South 83 degrees 33 minutes 46 seconds East, 1053.26 feet)

Thence, along said road:

S 55° 58' 0" W, 177.87 feet

S 57° 52' 0" W, 199.78 feet

S 53° 27' 0" W, 199.75 feet

S 47° 51' 0" W, 200.93 feet

S 47° 22' 0" W, 199.20 feet

S 60° 48' 0" W, 188.69 feet

N 82° 00' 0" W,186.80 feet

N 67° 12' 0" W, 396.45 feet to a railroad spike;

Thence, leaving said road and along the west –line of Section 10 and East-line of Vogt(299-282 O.R.)

N 6° 15' 15" E,670.56 feet to the point of beginning and containing 17.33 acres.
