## **EXHIBIT "A"**

Thence N 85°03'32" W along the Grantor's South property line, 249.80 feet to an iron pin found with an I.D. cap stamped "L.F.Swoyer-PS 6735", said iron pin found also being the real **point of beginning** of the parcel herein described:

Thence N 35°21'35" W along the Grantor's Southwesterly property line, 431.00 feet to a railroad spike found in the Grantor's most Westerly property corner and in Salem Road (Athens Co. Rd. No. 9);

Thence N 43° 16'10" E along the Grantor's Northwesterly line and Salem Road (Athens Co. Rd. No. 9), 240.01 feet to a railroad spike set;

Thence along the following two (2) courses through the Grantor's land:

- S 36°24'37 E, 220.42 feet to an iron pin set, passing through an overhead electric line power pole at 58.84 feet, and;
- 2. S 07°29'52" W, 351.88 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 1.7815 acres.

The bearings used in the above description are based on previous surveys and on the East line of the Northeast one-quarter of Section 4 as bearing: S 04°23'59" W, and are only for the determination of angles.
