Situated in the southeast quarter of Section 16, Town 12, Range 15, York Fownship, Athens County, Ohio and described as follows:

Commencing for reference at the northeast corner of said Section 16; thence on an assumed bearing of South 23°26'52" West 3,007.18 feet (calculated by leed Vol. 348 Page 811) to a found railroad spike at the southwest corner of a 3.08 acre tract described in Volume 348 Page 811 of the Athens County Deed Records, said found railroad spike is THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the south property line of said 3.08 acre tract South 87°46'40" East (passing a set iron pin at 30.00 feet) for a total distance of 523.19 feet to a set iron pin; thence leaving the south line of said 3.08 acre tract South 0°12'16" East 250.00 feet to a set iron pin; thence North 87°46'40" West (passing a set iron pin at 493.19 feet) for a total distance of 523.19 feet to a point in the center of State Route 691; thence along the center of said State Route 691 North 00°12'16" West 250.00 feet to the point of beginning containing 3.00 Acres and being a part of the third tract described in Volume 378 Page 127 of the Athens County Deed Records.

Note: Unless otherwise noted all set iron pins are 5/8 inch in diameter and 30 inches in length and capped with a plastic identification marker scribed Leonard F. Swoyer R.L.S. 6765.
