Thence N48 26'48"E 100.00 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin also being a corner of 0.81 acre parcel of M.J. and N. W. Blackburn as described in O.R. Vol. 37, Pg. 493, said pin also being on the right of way limits of said U.S. 33 (reference: iron pin set at 53.07 feet);

Thence S41 33'12"R 779.03 feet along said U.S. 33 right of way limits to an iron pin set;

Thence continuing along U.S. Rt. 33 right of way limits with a curve to the left, said curve having (arc definition) a length of 505.57 feet, a radius of 1893.47 feet, and a chord bearing g49 15'11"E 504.05 feet to an iron pin set (reference: concrete C&O right of way monuments found N74 36'24"E 6.2 feet and S63 18'48"E 36.5 feet);

Thence leaving said U.S. Route 33 right of way limits 631 10'05"W 37.45 feet to an iron pin set at the easterly corner of a 4.92 acre parcel of Nelsonville Limited as described in D.R. Vol. 325, Pg. 399;

Containing 2.57 acres (0.23 acres of parcel #13, D.R. 179, Pg. 579, 2.34 acres of parcel #5 D.R. 41, Pg. 131) as surveyed 02-16-1993 by Robert C. Canter, P.S. #7226; a print of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A-1.

BEING in part the same property acquired by The Columbus and Hocking Valley Railroad Company, a predecessor of Grantor, from Lorenzo Poston, et ux, by deed dated July 28, 1873, recorded among the Public Land Records of Evans County, Ohio in Book 41, Page 131.

AND BRING in part the same property acquired by The Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company, a predecessor of Grantor, from R. D. Williams, Trustee, by deed dated May 5, 1942, recorded as aforesaid in Book 179, Page 579.

The Ohio and West Virginia Railway Company, The Columbus and Hocking Valley Railroad Company and the Columbus and Toledo Railroad Company consolidated, effective August 20, 1881, to form the Columbus, Hocking Valley and Toledo Railway Company. The Columbus, Hocking Valley and Toledo Railway Company was acquired by The Hocking Valley Railway Company by deed dated February 25, 1899. The Hocking Valley Railway Company merged into The Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company May 5, 1930. Effective September 2, 1987, The Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company merged into CSX Transportation, Inc. in accordance with the terms of the Articles of Merger dated August 18, 1987.
