Thence N41 36'30.W 150.00 feet along a 4.92 acre parcel as described in D.R. Vol.325 Pg.399 to an iron pin found;

Thence N42 17'23"W 293.15 feet along the northeasterly line of a 4.38 parcel as described in D.R. Vol.347 Pg.305 to an iron pin found;

Thence along the lines of parcels as described in O.R. Vol.54, Pg. 38 the following two courses,

S85 55 58 E 94.26 feet to an iron pin found; N48 21'31"E 56.55 feet to a concrete C&O R/W monument found;

Thence S4f 52'57"E 225.85 feet along the right of way line of Canal Street (now U.S. 33) to an iron pin set at the northwest corner M.J. and N.W. Blackburn parcel as described in O.R. Vol.37 Pg.493;
