Being a portion of land acquired for the Ohio and Erie Canal, known as the Hocking Canal, under an Act of Legislature dated February 4, 1825, (O.L. Vol. 23, Sec. 8), amended February 13, 1832, (O.L. Vol. 30, Sec. 1), situated in the state of Ohio, Ohio River Survey, Town 12 North, Range 15 West, Athens County, York Township, city of Nelsonville, and further described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the southerly right-of-way line of DeSteiguer Street with the easterly right-of-way line of Parkway Drive; thence along the easterly right-of-way line of Parkway Drive, South thirty-nine degrees seven minutes no seconds East (S39°-07'-00"E), two hundred fifty and no hundredths (250.00) feet to the true point of beginning; thence along the prolongation of same line, fifty and no hundredths (50.00) feet to a point; thence leaving the easterly right-of-line of Parkway Drive, North fifty degrees fifty-three minutes no seconds East (N50°-53'-00"E), three and sixty hundredths (3.60) feet to a point on the easterly canal property line; thence along the easterly canal property line, North thirty-eight degrees fifty-three minutes fifteen seconds West (N38°-53'-15"W), fifty and no hundredths (50.00) feet to a point; thence leaving the easterly canal property line, South fifty degrees fifty-three minutes no seconds West (S50°-53'-00"W), three and eighty hundredths (3.80) feet to the true point of beginning, and containing one hundred eighty-five and no hundredths (185.00) square feet, (0.004 acre), more or less, all the above being subject to any existing grants, leases, easements, or any other interests granted herein, it being the intent of this instrument to convey only that portion of canal land located between Parkway Drive and Lot No. 523 of the Watkin's Addition in the city of Nelsonville.

All bearings and distances are based on a survey made by Paul L. Allen in 1932, titled "Plat showing marginal strips of the Hocking Canal in Nelsonville, Ohio," on file in the office of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Division of Public Works, at Columbus, Ohio, and also on file in Map Book No. 9, Pages 56-60 at the Recorder's Office in Athens County, Ohio.

The above description was prepared by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Division of Public Works and is based on a survey caused by the Superintendent of Public Works, authorized by Senate Bill No. 21, passed by the Ohio Legislature on March 28, 1888 and performed by Bruce Doughton in 1912, reference being made to Bruce Doughton Field Book No. 69, and to Hocking Canal Plat No. 26, all on file in the office of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Division of Public Works, at Columbus, Ohio.
