thence along the westerly line of the said Trustees of B.P.O.E. #543 parcel, South 07° 34' 38" West, a distance of 199.37 feet to a 5/8" rebar (30" long) with i.d. cap set in the northerly line of Canal Street (U.S. Route 33) of the Marginal Canal Lands Survey as recorded in plat envelope #424A;

thence along the said northerly line of Canal Street (U.S. Route 33) of the Marginal Canal Lands Survey, North 66° 15' 00" West, a distance of 424.05 feet to a 5/8" rebar (30" long) with i.d. cap set in the easterly line of Fulton Street;

thence along the said easterly line of Fulton Street, North 07° 26' 26" East, a distance of 93.09 feet to a 5/8" rebar (30" long) with i.d. cap set marking the southwesterly corner of Lot #4 in the said City of Nelsonville;

thence along the southerly line of Lot #4 through Lot #9 of the said City of Nelsonville, South 82° 26' 45" East, a distance of 481.49 feet to a railroad spike set marking the southwesterly corner of said Lot #10 in the City of Nelsonville;
