## EXHIBIT "A" 43.923 ACRE TRACT

Being a part of the tract of land that is now or formerly in the name of Huntington National Bank, Trustee, as recorded in Deed Book 162 at page 608, Athens County Recorder's Office, said tract being a part of 100 acre Lots 608 and 609 in Section 3 and Section 9, T12N, R15W, York Township, Athens County, State of Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point taken to be on the southeast corner of Section 9, T12N, R15W;

Thence along the south line of Section 9, North 84 degrees 24 minutes 14 seconds West a distance of 95.85 feet to a point on the east line of a tract in the name of the Athens County Commissioners recorded in Official Record330 at page 2420 from which a 5/8" iron pin set for reference bears North 84 degrees 24 minutes 14 seconds West a distance of 37.53 feet;

Thence along the east line of the Athens County Commissioners tract, North 17 degrees 09 minutes 57 seconds West a distance of 943.89 feet to a point on the north line of River Lot 609 from which a 5/8" iron pin set for reference bears North 84 degrees 30 minutes 20 seconds West a distance of 37.62 feet;

Thence along the north line of River Lot 609 South 84 degrees 30 minutes 20 seconds East a distance of 462.09 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set on the east line of Section 9;

Thence continuing along the north line of River Lot 609 South 84 degrees 13 minutes 03 seconds East a distance of 869.49 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a 1-1/4" plastic identification cap stamped "Swoyer" found on the southwest corner of a tract as recorded in Official Record 183 at page 492;

Thence continuing along the north line of River Lot 609 and along the south line of the tract as recorded in Official Record 183 at page 492, South 84 degrees 14 minutes 53 seconds East a distance of 643.14 feet to a point on the westerly Limited Access and Right of Way line of U.S. Route 33 from which a 5/8" iron pin with a 1-1/4" plastic identification cap stamped "Swoyer" found bears South 84 degrees 14 minutes 53 seconds East a distance of 3.56 feet;

Thence along said right of way line the following three courses:

1. With a curve to the left having a delta of 15 degrees 19 minutes 53 seconds a radius of 3195.78 feet an arc length of 855.13 and the chord bearing South 37 degrees 42 minutes 27 seconds East a distance of 852.58 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set,

2. South 52 degrees 15 minutes 55 seconds East a distance of 209.04 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set, and

3. South 27 degrees 54 minute 19 seconds East a distance of 168.72 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set on the south line of Section 3;

Thence leaving said right of ray line and along the south line of Section 3, North 84 degrees 15 minutes 56 seconds West, passing through a 5/8" iron pin set on the northeast corner of River Lot 606 at 588.85 feet, going a total distance of 1479.58 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a 1-1/4" plastic identification cap stamped "Branner" found on the northwest corner of River Lot 606;

Thence continuing along the south line of Section 3, North 84 degrees 15 minutes 56 seconds West, passing through a 5/8" iron pin set at 833.68 feet, going a total distance of 888.99 feet to the point of beginning containing 43.9230 acres, more or less, subject to all easements of record.

The bearings used in this survey are based on monuments found on the east line of Section 3 as bearing South 05 degrees 39 minutes 54 seconds West and are for the determination of angles only.

The iron pins set are 5/8" X 30" with a 1-1/4" plastic identification cap stamped "Seymour & Associates".


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
