The bearing in the above description are based on the north line of River Lot 651 bearing South 85° 28' 59" East. Iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebar, 30 inches long with plastic identification caps.

The above survey was made by Ronald M. Merckle, Ohio Registered Surveyor No. 6473, on November 5, 1984.

This conveyance is subject to the following conditions, which are accepted by the grantees by the recording of this instrument.

1. Grantor reserves all rights to the Simms #1 oil and gas well and all oil and gas produced therefrom until such time as the well is plugged and abandoned, along with rights to operate the well and to remove oil and gas produced from the well by pipelines or other convenient methods. Grantor agrees to plug and abandon the well at such time as the well interfers with the operations of the grantees. However, if the well is plugged and abandoned at the request of grantees, the grantees will pay all costs of plugging the well up to \$2,000. At such time as the well is plugged and abandoned all oil and gas rights in the well unit shall revert to the grantees. Grantor agrees to use all reasonable means to operate this well without interfering with operations of the grantees on the real estate herein conveyed.
