0.3865 ACRE TRACT

Beginning, for reference, at a tile monument found on the northwest corner of River Lot 652 in Section 30, York Township;

Thence along the west line of River Lot 652 South 04 degrees 16 minutes 27 seconds West a distance of 2120.00 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a 1-1/4" plastic identification cap stamped "Swoyer-6765" found;

Thence continuing along the west line of River Lot 652 South 04 degrees 06 minutes 46 seconds West a distance of 251.32 feet to a point on the south line of U.S. Route 33;

Thence leaving said river lot line and along the south line of U.S. Route 33, South 81 degrees 13 minutes 19 seconds East a distance of 30.00 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set for the principal point of beginning of the tract as recorded in Official Record 456 at page 2653;

Thence continuing along the south line of U.S. Route 33 the following two courses:

- 1. South 81 degrees 13 minutes 19 seconds East a distance of 55.41 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set, and
- 2. South 69 degrees 54 minutes 43 seconds East a distance of 74.59 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set;

Thence leaving said line of U.S. Route 33 South 04 degrees 06 minutes 46 seconds West, passing through a 5/8" iron pin set at 45.51 feet, going a total distance of 123.28 feet to a point in the center of the Hocking River;

Thence along the center of said river, North 80 degrees 09 minutes 02 seconds West a distance of 127.58 feet to a point;

Thence North 04 degrees 06 minutes 46 seconds East, passing through a 5/8" iron pin set at 85.87 feet, going a total distance of 135.56 feet to the principal point of beginning, containing 0.3865 acre, more or less, subject to all easements of record pertaining to this tract.

The iron pins set in this survey are 5/8"X30" with a 1-1/4" plastic identification cap stamped P.S.-6044.

The bearings used in this survey are based on monumentation found on the north line of U.S. Route 33 as bearing North 69 degrees 54 minutes 43 seconds West and are for the determination of angles only.
