## 0.078 ACRE PUBLIC ROAD

Situated in the Village of Buchtel Section 6, Town 12, Range 15, York Township, Athens County, Ohio and described as follows:

Commencing at a set iron pin at the southeast corner of Lot 157 in the said Village of Buchtel, thence along the south line of said Lot 157 South 69 degrees 46 minutes 39 seconds West, a distance of 27.00 feet to a set iron pin, THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence leaving the south line of said Lot 157 South 55 degrees 31 minutes 18 seconds East, a distance of 60.14 feet to a set iron pin; thence South 43 degrees 03 minutes 58 seconds East, a distance of 63.18 feet to a set iron pin on the north right of way line of State Route 78, the point of curvature of a non-tangent curve, concave to the North, having a radius of 1859.86 feet, a central angle of 0 degrees 36 minutes 58 seconds, and a chord of 20.00 feet bearing South 75 degrees 35 minutes 33 seconds West; thence West along said curve, a distance of 20.00 feet to a point (witness a found iron pin South 45 degrees 42'minutes 21 seconds East 1.59 feet); thence leaving the north right of way line of said State Route 78 and along the easterly line of a 0.2 acre tract described in Volume 374 Page 583 of the Athens County Deed Records North 45 degrees 42 minutes 24 seconds West, a distance of 52.72 feet to a found iron pin; thence North 62 degrees 46 minutes 28 seconds West, a distance of 70.69 feet to a found iron pin; thence North 86 degrees 25 minutes 15 seconds West, a distance of 33.36 feet to a point on the south side of a 16 foot alley; thence leaving the easterly line of said 0.2 acre tract North 1 degrees 44 minutes 55 seconds East, a distance of 16.00 feet to a set iron pin on the north side of said alley and the south line of Lot 156 in said Village of Buchtel; thence along the south line of Lot 156 and Lot 157 in said Village of Buchtel South 88 degrees 02 minutes 22 seconds East, a distance of 60.09 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.078 acre, and being a part of a tract described in Volume 270 Page 312 of the Athens County Official Deed Records.

Note: Unless otherwise noted, all set iron pins are 5/8 inch diameter rebar and 30 inches in length and capped with a plastic identification marker inscribed L.F. Swoyer P.S. 6765.
