Beginning for reference at the Point of Commencement at a Stone Found at the Southwest corner of Section 20. Thence with the South line of Section 20, S 80°-55'-14" E - 1615.912 feet to a point in a tree stump on the South line of Section 20. Said

point is the Principal Place of Beginning for this survey.

Thence with a new division line of Gambill (O.R. 395 Pg. 724), N 07°- 34'- 41" E -709.106 feet to a point in the centerline of Perry Ridge Road (Twp. Rd. 268, 25-foot right-of-way), passing an Iron Pin set this survey at 7.500 feet and at 695.147 feet. Thence with the centerline of Perry Ridge Road (Twp. Rd. 268, 25-foot right-of-way) the following 3 courses;

S 55°-59'-28" E – 189.565 feet to a point, S 47°- 32'- 52" E - 512.430 feet to a point, S  $42^{\circ}$ -  $12^{\circ}$ -  $30^{\circ}$  E - 126.210 feet to a point.

Thence leaving Perry Ridge Road and with the East line of Gambill and the West line of Allen (Vol. 208 Pg. 274), S 07°- 34'- 41" W - 268.240 feet to a ½-inch rebar found on the South line of Section 20, passing a Magnail set this survey at 16.369 feet.

Thence leaving the East line of Gambill and the West line of Allen and with the South line of Section 20 and the North line of Section 19 and Stumbo (O.R. 153 Pg. 199), N 80°-55'-14" W - 686.767 feet to a point in a tree stump on the South line of Section 20, passing an Iron Pin set this survey at 682.767 feet. Said point in tree stump is the Principal Place of Beginning for this survey. This survey contains 8.000 Acres, more or less.
