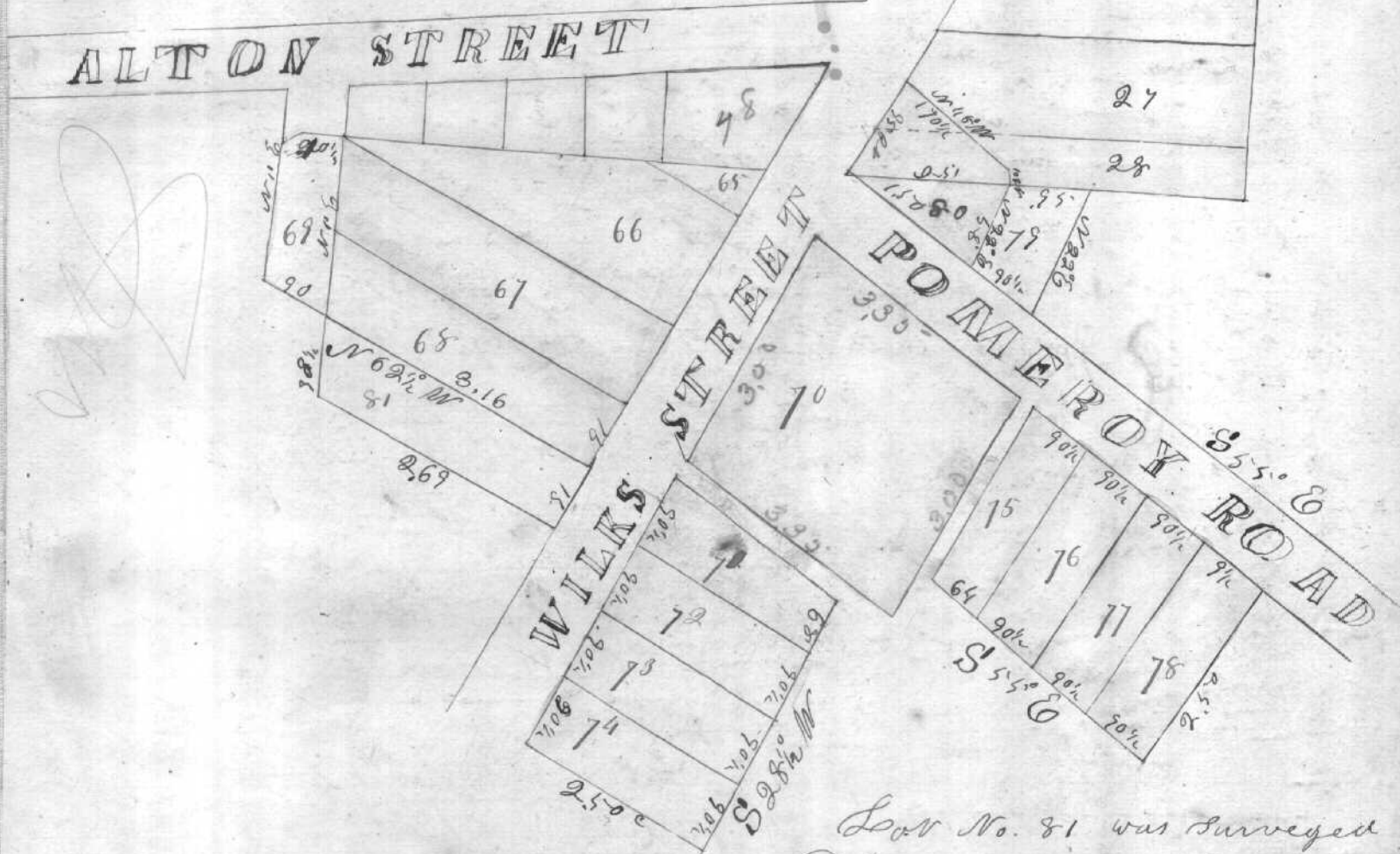

North by Mrs. Grahams addition South by land owned by Amos Thomson. Lots 11 in No. (69 to 80) inclusive except 7) are either parallel or at right angles to the streets on which they are located unless their particular bearings is noted on the Plat

Resolved by the Council of the Village of Albany, Ohio, in regular session assembled that.

Whereas- The Old Plat of said Village shows an alley running along the South side of Lot #70 in said Village, from Wilkes Street East to Out Lot #147.

And Whereas- said Alley has never been opened to the use of the public, but on the contrary has for fifty years been sold and deeded with that portion of Lot #70 now owned by C.A. Parker, and there having never been any demand to open said alley to the use of the public.

Now therefore- the Council declares said alley abandoned, and to clear C.A. Parkers title to land now controlled by him, and in consideration One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby transfer to C.A. Parker any interest said Village may have in said alley.
