TRACT "A":

Being a part of the 2.606 Ac. tract described in Vol. 280, Pg. 584, Athens County Deed Records, situated in Sec. 3 of Ames Twp., T-6N, R-13W, Village of Amesville, Athens Co., Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning, for reference, at a point on the east line of Maple St. from which, by previous survey, the SW corner of Lot 108 of said Amesville Village bears S 87 degrees 31' 33" W a distance of 318.27 ft.;

Thence, S 3 degrees 09' 50" E a distance of 32.00 ft. to the southwesterly corner of the 2.606 Ac. tract of which this survey is a part;

Thence, with the south line of said 2.606 Ac. tract, N 86 degrees 29' 11" E a distance of 423.41 ft. to an iron pin set, said pin being the principal place of beginning for the tract herein described;

Thence with new lines the following two (2) courses:

- 1) N 9 degrees 47' 17" W a distance of 142.87 ft. to an iron pin set;
- 2) N 15 degrees 26' 48" E, passing an iron pin set at 96.64 ft., going a total distance of 100.22 ft. to a point on the south side of St. Rt. 550;

Thence with lines parallel to and 30.0 ft. southerly of the centerline of said state route the following two (2) courses:

- 1) S 46 degrees 38' 10" E a distance of 84.00 ft. to a point;
- 2) S 49 degrees 35' 25" E a distance of 33.89 ft. to an iron pin set;

Thence, leaving St. Rt. 550, S 7 degrees 23' 33" W a distance of 154.77 ft. to an iron pin set on the south line of said 2.606 Ac. tract;

Thence, with said south line, S 86 degrees 29' 11" W a distance of 69.49 ft. to the principal place of beginning, containing 0.4285 acre, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements.

Cited bearings are based on a previous survey making the east right-of-way of Maple St. run N 3 degrees 09' 50" W.
