Thence along the centerline of the public road N. 76° 15' 30" E., 276.54 feet to a point;

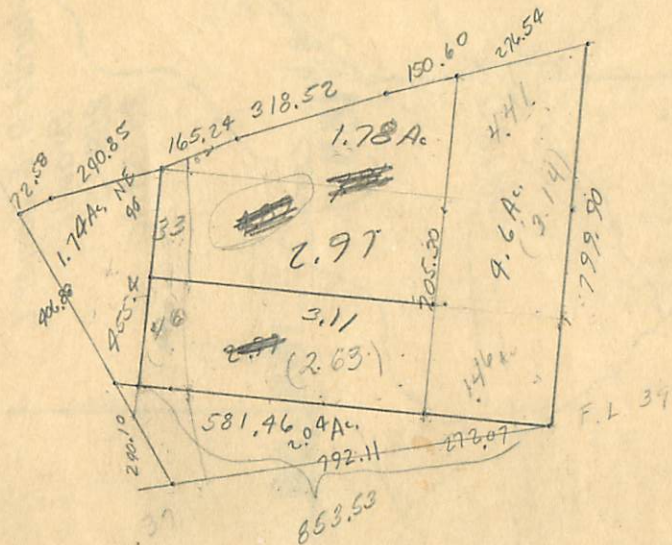
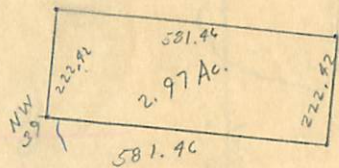

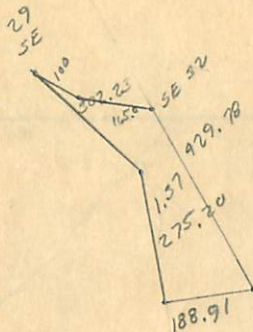
