Situated in the northwest quarter of Section 25, Bern Township, Town 7, Range 12, Athens County, Ohio and described as follows:

Commencing at a three foot hickory tree at the northwest corner of Section 25, said tree is also THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the north line of said Section 25 South 80°34'20" East (passing a set iron pin at 5.00 feet) for a total distance of 205.83 feet to a set iron pin; thence on a random line the following two bearings and distances:

- 1) South 01°05'39" West 292.67 feet to a set iron pin; thence
- 2) South 80°34'20" East (passing a set iron pin at 670.00 feet) for a total distance of 700.00 feet to a point in the center of Bern Township Road 216; thence along the centerline of said road South 19°05'14" West 100.00 feet to a point; thence leaving said road on a random line North 88°53'22" West (passing a set iron pin at 15.00 feet) for a total distance of 938.96 feet to an iron pin set on the west line of said Section 25; thence along the west line of Section 25 North 09°10'00" East 524.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 5.078 acres and being a part of a 107.83 acre tract described in Volume 313 Page 713 of the Athens County Deed Records.

Note: Unless otherwise noted all set iron pins are 5/8 inch in diameter and 30 inches in length and capped with a plastic identification marker scribed Leonard F. Swoyer R.L.S. 6765.
