

DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR LEWIS FERRELL

Being a part of the tract of land in the name of Lewis Ferrell as recorded in Deed Book 220 at page 591, Athens County Recorder's Office, said tract being situated in the southwest quarter of Section 25, T7N, R12W, Bern Township, Athens County, State of Ohio, and more particularly described as follows"

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set on the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 25, T7N, R12W;

Thence with the west line of said quarter quarter, North 0° 14' 19" East a distance of 229.43 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set;

Thence South 88° 43' 22" East a distance of 1349.31 feet to a 15" blazed walnut tree corner from which a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set for reference bears North 80° 00' 14" West a distance of 8.10 feet;

Thence South 2° 38' 03" West a distance of 199.58 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set;

Thence with the south line of said quarter quarter, West a distance of 1340.75 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.9646 acres, more or

The bearings used in the above described tract were derived from assuming the south line to be due east and west and are for the determination of angles only.
