Being a 0.9455 acre tract out of a 30.0 acre tract that is now or formerly in the name of PW Development, Inc. as recorded in Official Record 127 at pages 819, 821, 823, 825 and 827, Athens County Recorder's Office, said tract being situated in Section 20, (River Lots 341 and 342), Village of Chauncey, T10N, R14W, Dover Township, Athens County, State of Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set in the grantor's northwest corner, the southwest corner of a 12.0 foot wide unimproved alley, being the southwest corner to "Nye's Fifth Addition to Chauncey" as recorded in Envelope 241-A, and the east right of way line of Plum Street, said iron pin set bearing South 02 degrees 48 minutes 18 seconds East a distance of 12.03 feet from a point in the southwest corner of Lot 250 in said "Nye's Fifth Addition";

Thence along one of the grantor's north lines, the south line of the unimproved alley, and the south line of said addition, North 89 degrees 38 minutes 04 seconds East a distance of 125.00 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set;

Thence leaving the grantor's north line, the south line of the unimproved alley and the south line of said addition, South 02 degrees 48 minutes 18 seconds East a distance of 209.70 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set;

Thence South 00 degrees 52 minutes 30 seconds East a distance of 120.00 to a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set;

Thence South 89 degrees 38 minutes 04 seconds West a distance of 125.00 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set on one of the grantor's west lines and the east line of a 0.03 acre tract as recorded in Deed Book 331 at page 635 as the fourth tract;

Thence along one of the grantor's west lines and the east line of said 0.03 acre tract, North 00 degrees 52 minutes 30 seconds West, passing through a point from which an iron pipe found bears North 89 degrees 07 minutes 30 seconds East a distance 0.10 feet, said point being the northeast corner of the 0.03 acre tract and the southeast corner of a 12.0 foot wide unimproved alley extension and passing through an iron pipe found at 25.99 feet, said iron pipe being on the northeast corner of said unimproved alley extension and the southeast corner of another 0.03 acre tract as recorded in Deed Book 331 at page 635 as the second tract, going a total distance of 120.00 feet to an iron pin found in the northeast corner of said 0.03 acre tract (second tract), the east right of way line of Plum Street and the south right of way line of Lexington Street (A.K.A. Poplar Street), said iron pin found also being in the southeast corner of "The Nye Addition to Chauncey" as recorded in Envelope 216-B, ;


