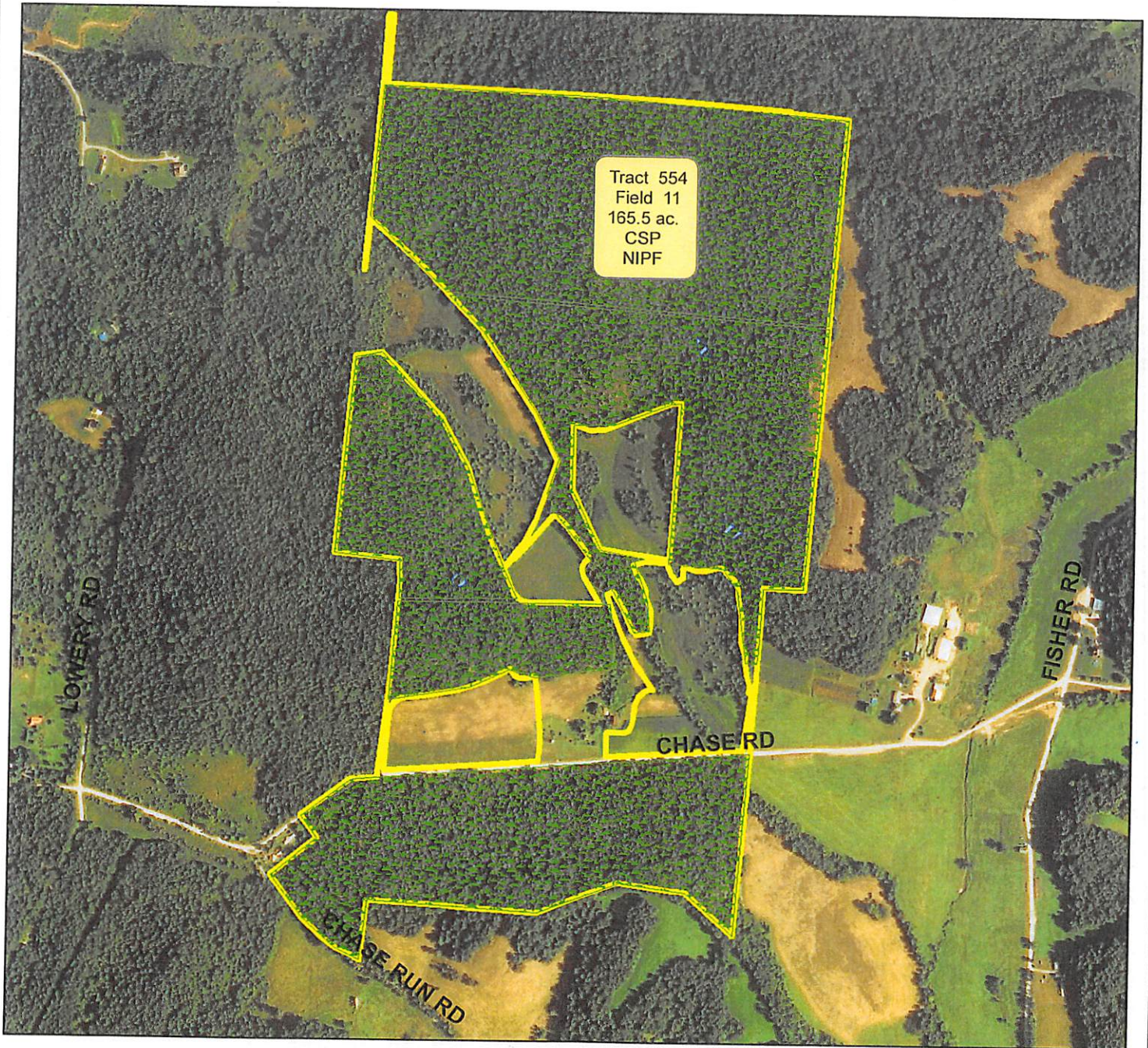

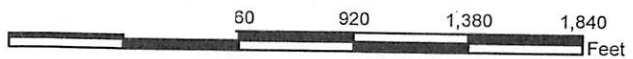



This activity consists of managing forestland and forested riparian areas by creating new potential roost trees within a forest and associated riparian areas to achieve desired summer habitat for forest dwelling bat species. No Felling of trees between April 1 to September 30 to prevent disruption of Indiana Bat. Trees 5 inches or less DBH shall be girdled using a chainsaw; trees larger than 5 inches DBH shall be girdled by other means.






