thence, South 58 degrees 14 minutes 37 seconds East, a distance of 300.09 feet to a point;


thence, South 66 degrees 57 minutes 09 seconds East, a distance of 112.97 feet to the POINT OF SEGINNING and containing 8.00 acres.


